

**2021-22 HKU Foundation Entrance Scholarships for Students of
HKU-University of California, Berkeley Dual Degree Programme**
Conditions of Award

The award of the HKU Foundation Entrance Scholarships is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) that any information regarding this award should be kept **confidential**;
- (b) that you are registered as a full-time student in the HKU-University of California, Berkeley Dual Degree Programme (DDP) in the academic year 2021-22 and commence study in September 2021;
- (c) that the award will cover your first and second year of DDP study at HKU;
- (d) that the scholarship is renewable for the second year of your DDP study subject to satisfactory performance. Specifically, you are expected to achieve a cumulative grade point average (cGPA) of 3.0 or above at HKU in the first year; otherwise your scholarship would be withdrawn in the second year;
- (e) that your appeal for scholarship review would not be considered during your DDP study;
- (f) that your scholarship will not be disbursed during the semester(s) when you are on leave of absence, except when you are participating in study abroad programme(s), arranged/recognised by HKU or UC Berkeley, in which you are expected to enroll and complete a normal load of study without failing any courses;
- (g) that you act as a goodwill ambassador for Hong Kong and the University. You may be invited to conduct presentations on your studies and share your experiences with students, staff, donors and guests of the HKU in various occasions;
- (h) that you are required to submit, via the Admissions Office of Registry, HKU, a “thank-you letter” to the donor in each academic year after you received the scholarship package in September; and
- (i) that the scholarship amount and terms of renewal are subject to change should your student status change.

Should you fail to meet any of the above conditions, this award may be withdrawn, and if the scholarship has been disbursed, you may be required to reimburse the scholarship sum, in full or in part, at the discretion of the University.
