

## **Entry Arrangements to Hong Kong**

### **For Full-time Degree students from the Mainland**

1. **Save** the “Notification Slip for Entry Visa / Permit” (e-Visa permit) and the Letter(s) issued by the Hong Kong Immigration Department **on your mobile device or print them on A4 white papers. Keep these documents in safe custody.**
2. **Apply** for an "Exit-entry Permit for Travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macao" (EEP) 【往来港澳通行证】 (if necessary) and a relevant exit endorsement 【相關赴港簽注】 from the relevant Mainland authorities.
3. When entering Hong Kong, you should **present BOTH** (1) the **EEP card** 【港澳通行证】 bearing the **exit endorsement D** 【逗留 D 簽】 and, (2) the **e-Visa permit** at the immigration counter so as to activate your student visa.
4. Before leaving the immigration counter, please ensure that you receive a white **landing slip**. Please check the following information on it:
  - 1) **Student** – Permitted to remain until “dd/mm/yyyy” → **This will be your visa expiry date**
  - 2) Studying the approved course at THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG
  - 3) Your English name
  - 4) Travel document number
  - 5) Arrival date

**You are advised to keep safely your visa and landing slip. Please DO NOT LOSE THEM throughout your stay in Hong Kong.**

5. No Objection Letter (NOL)

Upon the issuance of student visa, “eligible students” will receive a “No Objection Letter” (NOL) from the HK Immigration Department (ImmD) along with their student visa packages. The NOL will spell out the type(s) and conditions of employment which the student may take up for the academic year. **Please DO NOT discard this letter and keep it in a safe place for future reference. \*\*Note 1**

6. Change of student status and visa extension

Please note that **each student has a responsibility to obtain and maintain a valid student visa status during the studying period at HKU**. If you have extended your study or your limit of stay is shorter than the normal duration of your study programme, you should apply for visa extension 4 weeks before your limit of stay expires. It is also **your responsibility to report to the ImmD should there be any change in your study status**, and seek their prior approval for any change in your curriculum, institution etc.

*If there is any wrong information on your NOL, it will NOT affect your entry to Hong Kong with the e-Visa permit. Our office will work with HK ImmD for a revision after the semester starts in Sep/Oct 2024. Please wait for the updates in due course.*
