Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE)

Applications are invited for admission in September 2025 to the one-year full-time and the two-year part-time Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) programme.

Programme Aim

The PGDE programme prepares university graduates to teach in Hong Kong. The PGDE is a teacher training qualification recognized by the Education Bureau of the HKSAR Government.

Admissions Requirements

A candidate shall satisfy both the University Admissions Requirements and the Programme Specific Requirements as listed below.

All candidates shall:

1. comply with the [General Regulations](#) and the [Regulations for Taught Postgraduate Curricula](#);
2. hold a Bachelor's degree of this University or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
3. normally be expected to have completed a substantial portion of their undergraduate studies in the major subject for which they wish to apply.

In addition,

4. a part-time applicant shall normally be a serving teacher in Hong Kong schools with a minimum of one year of relevant teaching experience;
5. a candidate who is seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong where the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to higher degrees as prescribed under General Regulation G2(b) having:
 - a) a score of 550 or above (paper-based test) or 80 or above (internet-based test) in the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)[#]; or
 - b) a minimum overall band of 6 with no sub-test lower than 5.5 in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS)[#]; or
 - c) grade C or above in either the Overseas General Certificate of Education, the International General Certificate of Secondary Education, or the Cambridge Test of Proficiency in English Language.
6. all candidates shall satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination, if required.

Applications for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case-by-case basis.

[#] For admission, only TOEFL/IELTS scores recorded in the two years before the date of application will be considered.

¹ Subject to the availability of government funding, full-time students in the Chinese and English Language Education majors are required to participate in a compulsory six-week Experiential Learning non-local immersion programme in a Putonghua or English speaking context respectively during Semester One 2025.

Subject Test/Interview

Applicants who are shortlisted may be invited to attend a subject test and/or an interview and will be informed by email (at least one day before the interview). Applicants are advised to check their email for confirmed arrangements.

Candidates are required to pay a non-refundable deposit on acceptance of offer of admission:

- for FT candidates, HK\$22,250* for local students and HK\$91,000* for non-local students[△]
- for PT candidates, HK\$11,125* for local students and HK\$45,500* for non-local students[△]
- Successful candidates are also required to pay caution money of HK\$350 with the deposit.

[△] For the purpose of admission of non-local students, “non-local students” are defined as students holding (a) a student visa/entry permit; (b) a visa/entry permit under the Immigration Arrangements for Non-local Graduates (IANG); or (c) a dependent visa/entry permit who were 18 years old or above when they were issued with such visa/entry permit by the Director of Immigration. Submission of Application

- * Please submit **one** application with a complete set of supporting documents for **each** Major applied for (Note: Different study mode/study streams of the same Major are regarded as two programmes).
- * Applicants are **not** allowed to transfer from the chosen Major subject, study mode or study stream of the chosen Major once an online application has been submitted.

Submission of Supporting Documents

After submission of an online application, you are required to **upload the supporting documents** by logging on to <https://www.admissions.hku.hk/tpg/login.html> by the application deadline or within four weeks from the date of creation of your account, whichever is earlier. Posting of documents is NOT required at the application stage. Please refer to the “**Instructions for Submitting Supporting Documents**” for details. Should an applicant be considered for admission, he/she will receive an email notification from the PGDE Programme Office to submit the required documents. Please note that our request to submit documents does not necessarily mean that you will receive an offer of admission.

Announcement of Results

Successful applicants will be notified of the admission results by **email** and will receive an official Offer of Admission enclosing a Notice of Admission statement. Applicants who do not hear from the Faculty of Education by June 30, 2025 may assume their application unsuccessful. No individual notifications will be sent.
