

# The University of Hong Kong Faculty of Engineering Master of Science in Electronic Commerce and Internet Computing

Applications are invited for admission in September 2024 to a curriculum leading to the degree of Master of Science in Electronic Commerce and Internet Computing.

## Mode and Period of Study

The curriculum shall normally extend over one academic year of full-time study or two academic years of part-time study. For both full-time and part-time modes, the period of study shall include any assessment to be held during and/or at the end of each semester.

#### Instructions for applicants

Please read through the instructions and guidelines before starting to fill in the application.

#### Eligibility

To be eligible for admission to the programmes, a candidate shall satisfy both the University Admissions Requirements including but not limited to:

(a) shall comply with the General Regulations;

(b) shall hold a Bachelor's degree of this University or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose;

(c) for a candidate who is seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to high degrees as prescribed under General Regulation G2(b).

(d) satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case by case basis.

### English Language Requirement

Applicants who wish to be admitted on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong where the language of teaching and /or examination is not English shall satisfy the University English language requirement unless in exceptional circumstances they are exempted from this requirement.

#### **Application Fee**

The application fee is HK\$300 per application (non-refundable), and payment should be made online.

#### Announcement of Results

Applicants who do not hear from the Faculty of Engineering by July 31, 2024 may assume their applications unsuccessful.

#### Submission of Supporting Documents

The following documents should be uploaded to the Taught Postgraduate (TPg) programmes online admission system under Faculty of Engineering:

- 1. Graduate transcript(s) with grading system of all tertiary level studies (or interim transcript if graduate transcript is not yet available).
- 2. Officially certified Degree certificate(s), if available.
- English language proficiency test score report, such as TOEFL or IELTS (only for applicants with qualifications from institutions outside Hong Kong of which the language of instruction and / or examination is not English)
- 4. Proof of the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) / average grade / average mark
- 5. Official proof of class ranking, if available
- 6. A curriculum vitae (C.V.)
- 7. Others: Identity documents; Visa / Entry Permit (if applicable)

Applicants are NOT required to submit original documents during the application stage. Should an applicant be given an admission offer by the Programme, he/she will receive notification of the need to submit original/certified true copy<sup>\*</sup> of the documents to the HKU MSc Programme Office.

Please note that documents once submitted will not be returned, and will be destroyed if the application is unsuccessful.

\* The University will only accept original or copies of the documents that have been duly declared as true copies before a notary public.

#### **Composition Fee**

The proposed composition fee for 2024/25 intake is HK\$210,800 (local) and HK\$281,000 (non-local), subject to the University's approval.

The composition fee is payable on an annual basis. Payment shall be by two identical instalments for full-time study within the normative period of study (one year) and four identical instalments for part-time study within the normative period of study (two years). The composition fee will continue to be charged on semester / yearly basis beyond the normative period of study.

#### Definition of Non-local students

For the purpose of admission of non-local students, "non-local students" should be defined as students holding a) student visa/ entry permit; b) visa/entry permit under the Immigration Arrangements for Non-local Graduates; or c) dependant visa/ entry permit who were 18 years old or above when they were issued with such visa/ entry permit by the Director of Immigration.
