The usual duration of the programme is one academic year of full-time study or two academic years of part-time study. The application deadlines are:

- Clearing Round: 12:00 noon (GMT +8) on 29 February 2024 (Thursday)

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

To e eligible for admission to the programme, applicants shall:

- a) comply with the General Regulations and the Regulations for Taught Postgraduate Curricula; and
- b) hold the degree of Bachelor of Laws with at least a second-class honour of this University, or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose; or
- hold the degree in a discipline other than law with at least a second-class honour of this University, or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose; and have at least two years of relevant experience and/or professional qualifications; or
- have obtained either the Common Professional Examination of England and Wales or the Common Professional Examination Certificate of this University provided that, in either case, the candidate has also obtained a degree with at least a second-class honour of this University; or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University; or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose; and
- e) for a candidate seeking admission based on qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong for which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, they shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to higher degrees as prescribed under <u>General Regulation G2(b)</u>.

The Faculty has its specific requirements with regard to IELTS and TOEFL tests²:

| Test | Minimum Requirement(s) |
|-----------------------------|---|
| IELTS (Academic) | An overall band of 7.0 or above with no subtest below 6.5 |
| TOEFL (Paper-based Test) | A score of 593 or above |
| TOEFL (Internet-based Test) | A score of 97 or above |
