**MASTER OF LAWS IN ARBITRATION AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION
(SEPTEMBER 2025 INTAKE)**

(Interested applicants are advised to visit the University's Taught Postgraduate Admissions website at <https://admissions.hku.hk/tpg/faculty/faculty-law> before submitting applications).

Applications are invited for admission in September 2025 to read for the degree of Master of Laws in Arbitration and Dispute Resolution [LLM(ARB&DR)]. The usual duration of the programme is one academic year of full-time study or two academic years of part-time study. The application deadlines are:

- Main Round: 12:00 PM (GMT +8) on December 13, 2024 (Friday)
- Clearing Round: 12:00 PM (GMT +8) on February 28, 2025 (Friday)

Due to the class schedule of the compulsory and core modules, interested applicants without a law degree are only eligible to apply for the part-time mode.

Admission offers may be made on a rolling basis, and late applications will only be considered if places are still available. For further detailed information, please see <https://llm.law.hku.hk/arbdr>.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission to the courses leading to the degree of Master of Laws in Arbitration and Dispute Resolution, a candidate:

- (a) shall comply with the [General Regulations](#) and the [Regulations for Taught Postgraduate Curricula](#); and
- (b) (i) shall hold the degree of Bachelor of Laws with at least second class honours of this University; or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose; or
- (ii) shall hold a bachelor's degree in a discipline other than law with at least second class honours of this University, or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose, and have at least two years of relevant experience and professional qualifications; and
- (iii) shall have obtained either the Common Professional Examination of England and Wales or the Common Professional Examination Certificate of this University provided that, in either case, the candidate has also obtained a degree with at least second class honours of this University or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose; and

- (c) for a candidate who is seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to higher degrees as prescribed under [General Regulation G2\(b\)](#).

The Faculty has specific requirements regarding IELTS and TOEFL tests¹:

<u>Test</u>	<u>Minimum Requirement(s)</u>
IELTS (Academic)	An overall band of 7.0 or above with no subtest below 6.5
TOEFL (Paper-based Test) ²	A score of 593 or above
TOEFL (Internet-based Test) ²	A score of 97 or above
