1. Applications are invited for admissions in **September 2025** to curricula leading to the degree of Master of Science in Engineering in the fields of
 - Civil Engineering
 - Infrastructure Engineering and Management (subject to the University’s approval)

 - Building Services Engineering
 - Mechanical Engineering
 - Innovative Design and Technology
 - Microelectronics Science and Technology

 - Electrical and Electronic Engineering
 - Energy Engineering

 - Industrial Engineering and Logistics Management
 - Robotics and Intelligent Systems

Applications should be submitted via the online application system at <https://hku.hk/tpg>. When filling in the online application form, please provide a valid mailing address and email address to ensure the successful and confidential delivery of materials.

After paying the application fee and submitting the online application form, you will receive an email notification within approximately 5 – 10 working days. This email will provide instructions to log in to the Taught Postgraduate (TPg) Programmes Online Admission System under the Faculty of Engineering: <https://tpgadmission.engg.hku.hk> to upload the required supporting documents.

Mode and Period of Study

2. The curriculum shall normally extend over one academic year of full-time study or two academic years of part-time study. Candidates are not permitted to extend their studies beyond the maximum period of registration, which is two academic years of full-time study or three academic years of part-time study, unless otherwise permitted or required by the Board of Faculty.

Entry Qualifications

3. To be eligible for admission to the programmes, a candidate must meet both the University Entrance Requirements and the Programme Entrance Requirements including but not limited to:
 - (a) shall comply with the General Regulations;
 - (b) shall hold a Bachelor’s degree of this University or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
 - (c) for a candidate who is seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to high degrees as prescribed under General Regulation G2(b); and
 - (d) satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Regulations and Syllabuses

English Language Requirement

5. Applicants who hold a degree from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong where the language of teaching and/or examination was not English must satisfy the [University English language requirement](#)* for admission, unless they are granted an exceptional exemption.

* Please note that the University’s TOEFL code is 9671.

Application Fee

6. The application fee is HK\$300 per application. It is non-refundable and must be paid online.

Composition Fee

7. The proposed composition fee for 2025/26 intake is HK\$210,800 (local students) and HK\$320,000 (non-local students), subject to the University's approval.

The composition fee is paid annually in either two identical instalments for full-time students (within the one-year normative study period) or four identical instalments for part-time students (within the two-year normative study period). Students will be continuing to charge the composition fee on semester / yearly basis if they exceed the normative study period.

Admission Deposit

8. Upon acceptance of the offer of admission, applicants are required to pay a deposit consisting of the first instalment of the composition fee, the caution money (HK\$350), and the student activity fee (HK\$100, applicable to full-time students only). The first instalment will be applied toward the total composition fee. Fees once paid are not refundable.

Announcement of Results

9. Applicants who do not hear from the Faculty of Engineering by July 31, 2025 may assume their applications unsuccessful.
