 - c) Official academic transcripts (compulsory)
 - d) Graduation certificate
 - e) Resume
 - f) Personal Statement or Essay
 - g) Test Report of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) (non-home edition), or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) (if you have not been studying in the university in which the courses are taught in English).

Applicants will only be requested to submit hard copies of supporting documents when they receive an admission offer. Therefore, please do not submit hard copies to the Faculty Office before you receive the offer.

2. Applicants have to appoint 2 referees, who could be academic referees (existing/former teachers) or professional referees (existing/former supervisors), via the University's online application system (https://admissions.hku.hk/tpg/programme-list).

Both of your referees will be requested to complete an online referee report and upload a reference letter via a separate email sent by the Faculty on or before 12:00 noon (HKT), 2 January 2025.

** It is crucial that the applicants have to input accurate information on their online application form.

Any inaccurate information may cause email delivery failure and unavailable access to Faculty's Submission System. All application materials should be submitted by 12:00 noon (HKT), 2 January 2025.
