- 1. Applications are invited for admission in September 2024 to programme leading to the degree of Master of Public Administration. To be eligible for admission to the programme, a candidate shall satisfy both the University admission requirements and the programme specific requirements as listed below#:
 - (a) shall comply with the <u>General Regulations</u> and the Regulations for Taught Postgraduate Curricula;
 - (b) shall hold a Bachelor's degree of this University or a qualification of equivalent standard from this University or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose;
 - (c) for candidates who are seeking admission on the basis of a qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Hong Kong of which the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, shall satisfy the University English language requirement applicable to higher degrees as prescribed under General Regulation G2(b)*; and
 - (d) shall satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case by case basis.

- 2. The curriculum shall normally extend over one academic year of full-time study or two academic years of part-time study.
- 3. Applications for this taught postgraduate programme and payment of application fee (HK\$300 per application) should be made through the HKU on-line application system at http://www.hku.hk/tpg/.
- 4. The closing date for application is <u>12:00 noon, March 15, 2024.</u> The reviewing process starts from January 2024 on a rolling basis. Early applications are strongly encouraged.
